Venus High School is partnering with Hill College to offer the opportunity for students to enroll in Dual Credit college level courses. Through the Dual Credit courses, students will earn both high school credit and college credit hours. College tuition and fees will be provided for the students that are eligible for this program and show commitment.

The student:

- Is responsible for verifying that the dual credit course will be accepted by the college/university that he/she plans to attend upon high school graduation
- Is responsible for completing the online application, www.applytexas.com, prior to first semester of enrollment in a Dual Credit course
- Must obtain a grade of "C" or better in the Dual Credit course to earn high school credit
- **Must purchase the textbook(s) that are required for the Dual Credit course**
- Must complete the course. If a student decides to drop the college level course, he/she must notify the school counselor immediately and follow the college's procedure for dropping the course. Failure to do so will result in a grade of "F" for the student at the college level. In addition, the student will need to take the required course in high school. Dropping a Dual Credit course will also affect a student's participation in future Dual Credit courses.

In addition:

- All Dual Credit course grades will be monitored at Mid-Term. Any student not obtaining a passing grade before the drop deadline may be asked to drop the Dual Credit course and take the course at the high school level.
- **Any student dropping or making a grade below a "C" in a Dual Credit course will be required to reimburse Venus ISD for the entire cost of the tuition and fees for the course. Reimbursement must be made to Venus ISD prior to enrollment in any future dual credit courses.**
- All grades earned at the college level will be included in the student's college grade point average.
- Any student wishing to take a Dual Credit class to satisfy the requirements of the Distinguished Academic Graduation Plan must maintain a "B" or 3.0 average in the Dual Credit course.
- **Any student earning a grade of "C" will be placed on academic probation and will be subject to consequences as stated in the Dual Credit Handbook.**

I have read and understand the requirements and responsibilities of enrolling in a Dual Credit course. I understand that VISD will pay the tuition and fees to Hill College, but I will be responsible for purchasing the required textbook(s) prior to enrolling in a Dual Credit course. I also understand that if the Dual Credit course is dropped or a grade below a "C" is earned, I will be responsible for reimbursing Venus ISD the total cost of the tuition and fees.
