

# VPS/VES DRESS CODE 2021-2022

The dress code is established to teach grooming and hygiene, to prevent disruption, and minimize safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

- All clothing must be properly hemmed/cuffed. ***Holes are permitted below fingertip length when the hand is fully extended.***
- Hair must be neatly groomed and maintained out of eyes, and no extreme or fad hair-dos. No mohawks or designs cut into the hair.

Campus administration will have complete and final judgment on all matters concerning interpretation of the student dress code.

## **SHIRTS, BLOUSES, TURTLENECKS, SWEATERS, SWEATSHIRTS:**

- All shirts must be appropriately sized in the shoulders and length
- **Only school appropriate words and pictures will be allowed**
- No sheer or see-through tops
- No bare midriffs-shirts must cover back and stomach areas
- No tank tops or "spaghetti strap" shirts (must be 2 inches wide)
- Appropriate dress must be worn under sweaters/sweatshirts and jackets

## **JEANS, PANTS, SHORTS, SKORTS, SKIRTS, DRESSES:**

- Jeans, pants or slacks of any color
- No low-rise or oversized styles
- Shorts, skirts, skorts, and dresses should be fingertip length when the student's hand is fully extended down the side of the leg **even when worn with tights or leggings.**
- Shorts should be worn under dresses as students have PE every day.
- When wearing leggings your shirt/top **MUST** be fingertip length.

## **FOOTWEAR:**

- Athletic shoes or other shoes that are appropriate for P.E./recess with both closed toe and heel ***\*\*as students have P.E. everyday***
- No flip-flops, sandals, house shoes, Crocs, or slides
- No Heely's, skate shoes, or cleats

## **OUTERWEAR:**

- Hats, caps, and sunglasses are not to be worn in the building, except on school approved dress up days

**ID's** - Students are required to wear ID's while on campus. ID's may not be altered and must be visible.
